

LSE Eden Centre TeachMeet: call for contributions

New to the idea of TeachMeets? Here's [a brief summary](#) from TeachMeet Scotland.

Open to everyone who supports students in their learning.

Theme: What's the one thing learned during the last year that you will/might take forward in your practice?

- What did you try (willingly or less so!) that worked well?
- What did you try that didn't go as planned, but which you learned from anyway?

We ask you to reflect on and then share with colleagues some of the following:

- What did you want to happen? Why?
- What actually happened?
- How do you know what happened? What kind of evidence do you have?
- Why might this be relevant to wider practice?

Format

Informal, collaborative and collegial.

You can choose to contribute either a micro-presentation (7 minutes) or a nano-presentation (3 mins). Timings will be adhered to, so choose carefully!

Use of PowerPoint or similar is discouraged, but we will happily circulate summaries and/or resources after the event.

Each session will include a number of presentations followed by questions and discussion.
