## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMME

Every January to March, teams of LSE students undertake consultancy projects for charities. The LSE assembles and supports the teams, who meet with their charity partner every other week. Your team will conduct research into an issue your organisation faces and provide a fresh perspective, presenting it in a consultancy report.

## RESEARCH VOLUNTEERING SCHEME

The Research Volunteering Scheme, which runs every November to March, provides an excellent opportunity for charities to outsource literature reviews to LSE students. The LSE assembles the student teams and supports them in completing research papers and presentations, which answer research questions that charities provide.

## COMMUNITY ACTION PROJECTS

Community Action Projects is a scheme which gives students an opportunity to lead volunteering activities with Volunteer Centre support. Students can create projects within the LSE community to participate in volunteering on campus, as well as in partnership with local charities, such as one-off volunteering or charity collections.

## VOLUNTEERING PATHWAYS PROGRAMME

Alongside several other LSE Volunteer Centre initiatives, the Volunteering Pathways Programme promotes accessibility in volunteering. It runs from mid-July to September each year. The LSE recruits and supports the students and offers accessibility-related support for all participants.

**Charities apply to the scheme in the spring with role descriptions for individuals.**



## ONE-OFF VOLUNTEERING

One-off volunteering programme involves opportunities in which LSE students commit to one volunteering activity for a few hours or a day. This is designed to support charities who would benefit from the support of volunteers to deliver services or help with tasks, as well as students who would like to volunteer but have little time. The programme runs throughout the year, with the best time for student engagement during term time.
