Dr Susan Liautaud



We are delighted to welcome Dr Liautaud as our Guest of honour and speaker at this year's Annual Dinner. Dr Liautaud is LSE's Interim Chair of Council.

Susan is the Founder and Managing Director of a boutique advisory firm advising global leaders and corporate, non-profit, academic and governmental institutions internationally on complex ethics matters. She also founded a non-profit collaborative platform for debate on innovative ethics called The Ethics Incubator. She teaches cutting-edge ethics courses at Stanford University.

She serves on a number of other boards and advisory boards, including: the UK government's Centre for Data Ethics and Innovation board; UK Cabinet Office's Advisory Committee on Business Appointments; recent past Chair and member of the Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières US Advisory Board; and member of the board of directors of the Pasteur Institute, Care International Supervisory Board, Stanford HAI (Stanford Institute for Human Centered Artificial Intelligence) Advisory Council, and SAP AI Ethics Advisory Panel.

Susan holds a PhD in Social Policy from LSE; a Juris Doctor from Columbia University Law School; a M.A. in Chinese Studies from SOAS; a M.A. and two B.A.s from Stanford University. She was a Visiting Scholar at the Stanford Center of Philanthropy and Civil Society from 2012 to 2015.
