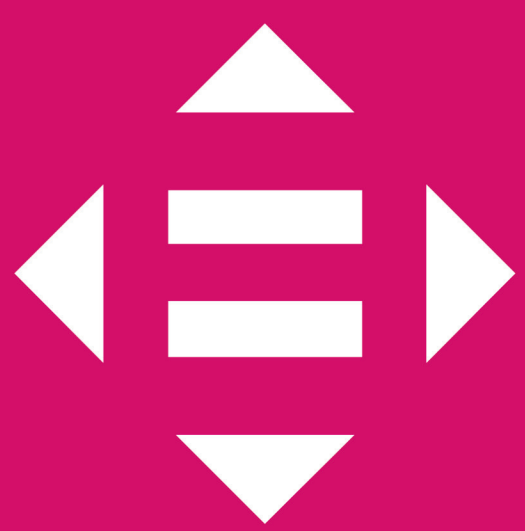

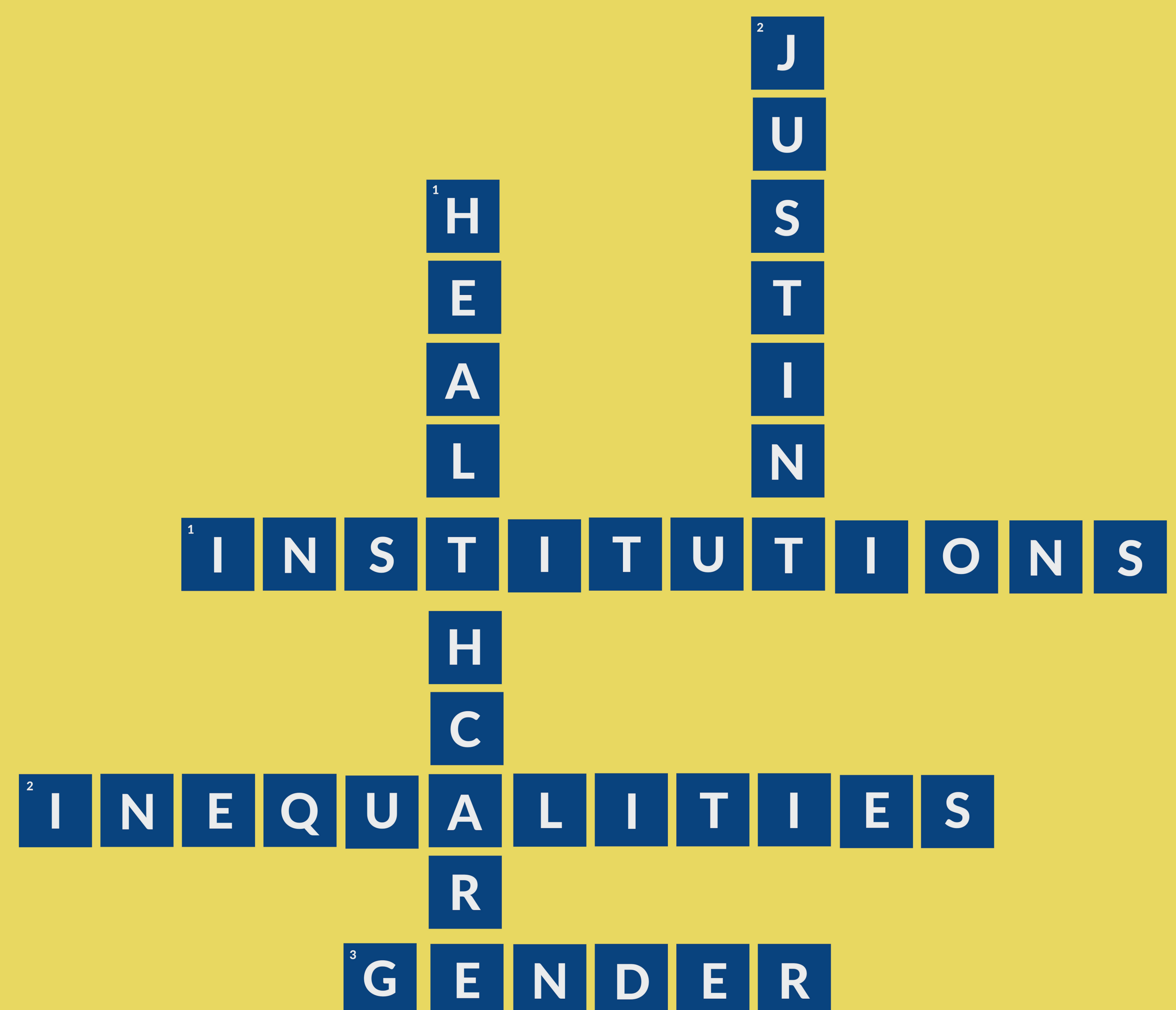
- ★ At the EI, we are experts at instituion building, and the SDGs are depent on coordinated efforts
