Research & Expertise: Access to Medicines

Focus on studying health systems, improving infrastructure, workforce capacity, and healthcare finance. Academics such as Dr Olivier Wouters' research contributes to achieving SDG targets 3.8 of universal health coverage & 10.4 of adopting policies to achieve equality.

Research & Expertise: Access to Long-Term Care

The department's focus includes long-term care financing, mental health, Out-of-Hospital Care, social care economics and unpaid care. Professor Martin Knapp's research will help global progress toward achieving SDG targets 10.2, which aims to empower people regardless of age & 3.4, which aims to reduce mortality by promoting mental healthcare.

Through the Care Policy and Evaluation Centre (CPEC), led by Professor Martin Knapp, the department is affiliated to international and national research groups under International Long-Term Care Network (ILPN) & National Institute of Health and Care Research (NIHR).



The Health Policy department engages extensively with external partners including national governments, large pharmaceutical companies, intergovernmental bodies and the WHO especially through LSE Health led by Prof Elias Mossialos.
