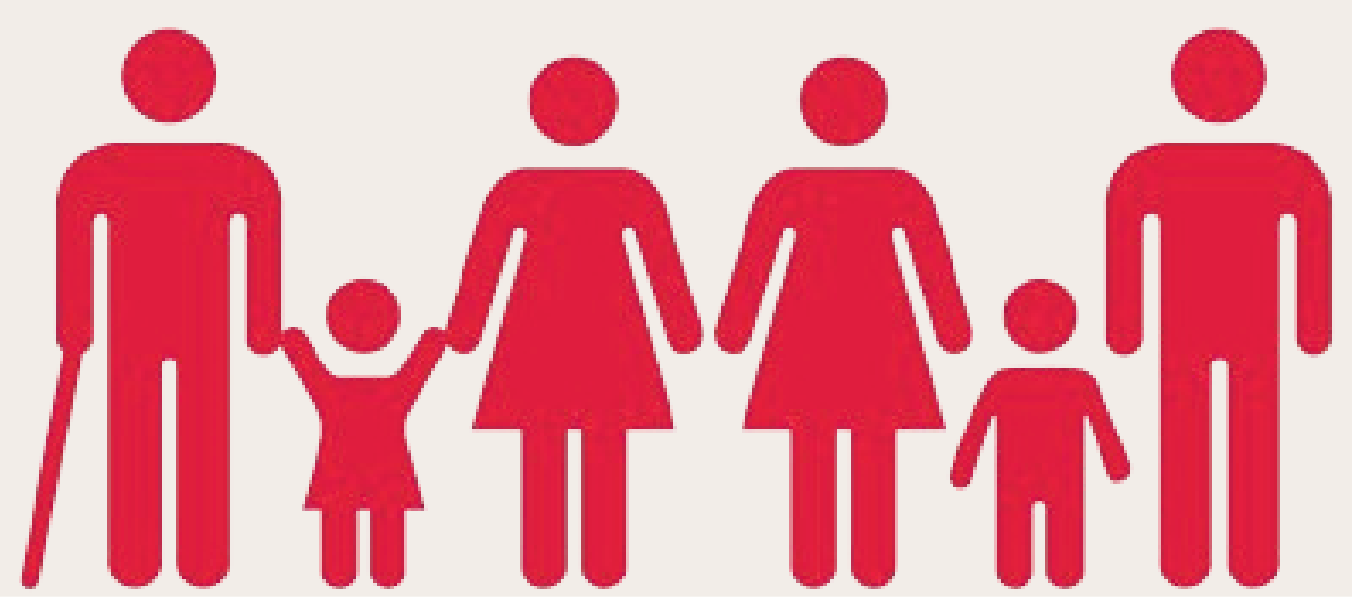
WHY WE CHOSE THESE SDGs?

PROGRESS OF SDG INDICATORS

670 million
...could still be living in extreme poverty today, and the figure will drop to...

575 million
...by 2030 – a fall of less than 30 per cent since 2015



The share of economic output earned by workers **declined by 1.5%** although, the observed decline is disconcerting
