

Proper scope of human activities




Desired mode of human activities

Redefining Environmental Protection

Professor Veerle Heyvaert

- Must close existing gaps between the public and private aspects of transnational regulation & legislation on environmental protection with **new legislation**
- Environmental regulation studied through transnationalisation of law because of its increasing regulation happening beyond the state



Ensuring Marine Protection

Dr Siva Thambisetty

- Key actor in designing the world's first High
 Seas Treaty
- Outlines main principles, obligations and processes that all states must follow during involvement in the high seas to safeguard marine life and the fair usage of marine genetic resources collected whilst doing so
- Established principles & processes required for equitable split of benefits in the context of intellectual property and gains made from the high seas
- Ensured developing countries also access a share of the profits stemming from work on the high seas

Global norms for navigating conflicting interests

Oliver Hailes

• Suggests limiting compensation awarded in investor-state arbitration

Joana Setzer

- Empowers **public access** to global resources on the climate policy, legislation and litigation
- Showing that climate litigation reduced firm value by -0.41% on average

- Shows how **regulatory intervention** should be proactive regarding the characteristics of systemic climate change risk creation
- Foresaw the rising prospect of **suing corporations** for climate change
