

Drafting programme learning outcomes: outward-looking approach

Reviewing comparator programmes will allow you to articulate more precisely what distinguishes your programme in terms of what the students are expected to learn and achieve. This approach will help you carve out a distinct identity for your programme that sets it apart (for prospective students).

Looking at the programme overviews/descriptions and programme learning outcomes (PLOs) of comparator programmes, consider:

- What distinguishes your programme? How is your programme positioned vis-à-vis comparator programmes?
For instance, the LSE LLB has a particular focus on legal philosophy and socio-legal studies as compared to LLB programmes in other universities which are focused more on the practice of black letter law.
- What are your programme's core competencies?

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
