### Update on utility investigations

In early November we advised you of the need to dig several trenches across the campus so our consultants can identify which utility diversions are required before the Centre Buildings redevelopment starts. This newsletter provides an update on these works and seeks to reassure the School community that we have listened to concerns raised and changed our approach to minimise disruption as far as possible.


## The Centre Buildings Redevelopment
