In October 2012 LSE Estates Division completed the redevelopment of the Tower One and Tower Two combined reception areas. The new joint reception provides a transformed and modernised entrance to the buildings. Security of the building was improved by the barriers with card readers provided at the single entry point. New features previously not available in the buildings include three meeting rooms, a café, advertising and display facilities for LSE Research Centres, soft seating areas and accessible facilities for users with special needs.

The new reception showcases some innovative architectural design features through construction materials used on the building façade and internally. Improvement to external landscaping made a significant difference to the approach into the buildings transforming the external environment in and around Clements Inn Passage. The new planter boxes with bio diverse shrubs complement the exterior of the building.
