The project includes the redevelopment of the site to create of a new nine storey building with two basement levels. The ground and basement levels will house fully equipped drama and music rehearsal spaces with sports facilities include a Sport England-standard multipurpose sports hall and two squash courts.

Entry to the building is through the Great Hall, a public space that can be accessed from three sides, providing a connection between Houghton Street and Lincoln's Inn Fields. The hall delivers flexible and convivial civic space which can also be used for large-scale events such as exhibitions, talks, dinners and open days. The first and second floors provide study spaces, lecture theatres and classrooms including three 90 seat Harvard style lecture theatres. Floors three to nine house the Departments of Accounting, Finance and Management, along with research hubs: the Financial Markets Group, the Systemic Risk Centre, and the Marshall Institute for Philanthropy and Social Entrepreneurship. Roof terraces are provided at a number of levels dedicated to both student and staff use.
