The refurbishment works Level 1 to 6 have now been completed.

The Department of Sociology moved into their new premises in July 2024 and Social Policy moved in September 2024.

Four new teaching rooms have also been created on the 1st floor and they will be available for use from January 2025.

The refurbishment has included the replacement of structure cabling throughout the building and the replacement of fire alarm services from level 1 to 6.






Atrium Lift - planned completion Apr 25.
