Welcome to the latest newsletter to keep you informed and updated on the works taking place at 44 Lincoln's Inn Fields. As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping you informed, we would like to advise you of our upcoming works on site.

From now until the end of the month, we are planning on completing the demolition of the first basement and ground floor slab. Piling works will utilise a mini piling rig on the Portsmouth Street elevation and within the basement area.

Our accommodation gantry has been completed which houses our welfare accommodation.

- Continue the demolition of the ground floor and first basement slabs
- Mini-piling secant wall along the Portsmouth Street elevation
- Installation of King post piles
- Begin installing the walling beams for the Level 1 prop install
- Installation of our logistics gantry (once demolition of the ground floor extends to Coopers Restaurant)
