Welcome to the latest newsletter to keep you informed and updated on the works taking place at 44 Lincoln's Inn Fields. As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping you informed, we would like to advise you of our upcoming works on site.

From now until this time next month we are planning on re-commencing our demolition works on the raft slab. We will also be continuing the installation of the level 2 of our horizontal propping scheme. The bulk excavation will begin in the areas where the raft has been previously demolished also.

We have reached an important milestone on the project with the dis-mantling of the site tower crane. Over the next four weeks, the works will involve using hydraulic hammers on the raft slab. There will be also increased volumes of site deliveries due to the bulk excavation.
