
LSE Marshall Fire Safety Works Newsletter

Hello LSE Marshall!

The Marshall Safety Works have been initiated, Overbury to use best endeavours to minimise the disruption to the building users whilst delivering the project. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this period. So far, the internal H&S temporary works have been successfully completed, and survey works are continuing whilst design works are developing for the construction production.

Over the next few weeks, the key activities that are anticipated to take place are

- Installation of the electrical cables from the basement to roof level via risers
- Removal of existing planters on L9 outdoor terrace area.

We are still waiting for the Westminster highway team's response for the crane license. A series of crane operations are planned for the project, and the dates will be confirmed when the Westminster Council confirms. During the crane operation, the GF and Basement (for bicycles) access from Lincoln's Inn Fields will be temporarily closed.

Communication Check-In points are proposed on 14th and 28th May, please join to discuss matters related to the building works.
