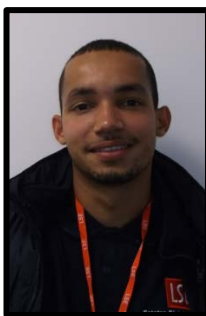
Jerell Kirnon - Mechanical Services Apprentice
