About the role

The Research and Innovation Division are looking to engage two MPhil/PhD students to help support the LSE Research Ethics Committee (REC). The role holders will work under the guidance of the Senior Research Ethics Manager, Dr Lyn Grove. In particular, the role holders will be expected to:

- become familiar with the LSE Research Ethics Policy and Procedures and related guidance;
- develop an understanding of the REC operating procedures and mode of reviewing applications;
- assist (following an induction period) with the review of MSc student ethics applications;
- attend and contribute to the Committee's termly meetings

Person specifications

The successful applicants should have experience of conducting qualitative research with human participants and a genuine interest in the area of research ethics.

Hours

These are hourly-paid roles. The initial 3 months (induction period, October to December) will only likely involve approximately 2 hours per week; from January to June the hours will slowly increase to approximately 5 to 6 hours per week.

Pay

The role will be paid at the equivalent of Band 6 point 25.00, which is an hourly rate of £26.50 per hour (including accrued holiday pay).
