Eligible Costs include:

- conference fees;
- travel and accommodation for conference or training attendance;
- Professional Association membership fees;
- specialist workshop or training fees.

In addition, specialist costs to make activities are also eligible including:

- costs to make reasonable adjustments within travel and accommodation bookings for staff who need them;
- costs to make activities more accessible such as transcription services, support staff;
- cost of child, parent or caring responsibilities if the carer is conducting activities away from home and is unable to make alternative arrangements.
